Access Solutions encompasses the entire spectrum of entry skills from zero damage to maximum carnage as well as discussing when to use which. Today's structure fires are more dangerous than ever before. Lightweight construction, low-mass synthetics, and open space floor plans have created a perfect storm for rapid, prolific fire growth and extreme behavior. It is imperative for firefighters of all ranks and experience levels to be prepared for this new battle. The Art of Reading Smoke, developed by Dave Dodson and continued by Rob Backer, provides the knowledge necessary for first-arriving firefighters, officers, and chief officers to determine the fire's location and progression "from the seat" before seeing any flame. This knowledge ensures that the correct tactics are implemented for the best possible outcome. Through the extensive use of actual fire ground videos, first-time students will develop, and return students will refine their knowledge and skills to become INTELLECTUALLY aggressive firefighters, rather than ARBITRARILY aggressive. The next generation of The Art of Reading Smoke brings new research, a new library of videos, and discussion on cancer prevention, tactics and strategies to blend today's fire service extinguishment and safety cultures into one cohesive unit.

## **Search and Rescue K9 Operations for Firefighters**

**Missouri Search and Rescue K9**

This class provides firefighters with an overview of Search and Rescue (SAR) K9 operations and how K9 teams integrate into emergency response incidents. Participants will learn the capabilities and limitations of SAR K9s, the types of incidents they can be utilized for, and how firefighters can effectively work alongside K9 handlers during search operations. Topics include K9 search disciplines (wilderness, human remains detection, disaster, and trailing), deployment considerations, scene management, safety around working dogs, and best practices for supporting K9 teams in the field.

Emphasis is placed on communication, coordination, and operational efficiency to maximize search effectiveness and ensure the safety of both responders and K9s. This presentation is designed to enhance firefighter awareness of SAR K9 resources and improve interagency cooperation during missing person incidents, disasters, and large-scale emergencies.
